

BCM Get Real! and JaM Camps - Booking Terms and Conditions

Bookings and Payment

Book online at <http://www.bcm.org.uk/book-camp-in-england-2019-bookings.html> or complete an application form (available from BCM) and return it to this address: Camp Bookings Co-ordinator, BCM International UK, PO Box 668, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 9PP.

Application forms must be accompanied by a non-returnable deposit of £35 for each child and balance of payment is due by **30th June 2019**. If paying online, full payment must be made at time of booking. Subject to availability, bookings will be accepted up to **30th June 2019**. As we are running two camps on one site places are limited so you are advised to book as early as possible. We reserve the right to refuse any application.

Fees for the camps are as follows:

JaM Camp	£170

If more than one child comes from the same family, the oldest child will pay full price but there will be a £20 discount for the first younger sibling and a £40 discount for the second younger sibling. Children do not need to attend the same camp to get the discounted price.

We are offering an extra £20 discount per camper for those who pay their fees in full by Friday 31st May.

The fees for camp include all food, accommodation, activities and outings. Throughout the week there will be opportunities to buy ice-creams, sweets, gifts and books for which campers will need a small amount of pocket money. Children's and Youth Bibles will be on sale at a subsidised cost of £5.

In case of financial hardship alternative arrangements may be available. Two possible sources of assistance are The David Chilcott Fund (dcfund.co.uk) and Leavers Coulson Trust (leaverscoulsontrust.org.uk). These are registered charities whose purpose is to help young people attend Christian residential holidays which they would otherwise not be able to afford. Please see their websites for further information.

Cancellation by you

To cancel your booking please write to the Camp Bookings Secretary at the office address. If you cancel your booking before 31st May you will lose your deposit. If you cancel between 31st May and 30th June you will lose your deposit and be liable for 50% of the remaining balance. If you cancel after 30th June you will forfeit the entire balance. **We strongly encourage you to take out insurance to cover any loss of fees due to cancellation.**

Cancellation by BCM

In the unlikely event of a camp having to be cancelled or curtailed by BCM (due to unforeseen circumstances) we guarantee to refund fees as follows:

- if the camp is cancelled before the start date, fees will be refunded in full
- if the camp is cut short after it has begun, a proportion of fees will be kept depending on the number of days for which camp has run.

Travel

You are responsible for your child's travel arrangements to and from camp. If assistance is required please talk to your local Bible club/church youth group leader.

Safeguarding/Health and Safety

It is our aim to provide a safe and happy environment at camp which will benefit your child physically and spiritually. BCM Camps are staffed by volunteers who adhere to our policies on Safeguarding and Health and Safety. Each volunteer is only accepted on the team on receipt of satisfactory references and a criminal records check. Medical

professionals look after campers' medical needs with the assistance of qualified first-aiders. Our cooks provide a nutritious varied menu. The children sleep in single-sex dormitories with staff sleeping nearby.

Behaviour

We expect all children and teenagers who come on camp to behave well and join in every aspect of the programme. Any camper who persistently disobeys leaders or causes harm to others will be sent home. It will be their parents' responsibility to collect them from camp and no fees will be refunded.

Photographs and phones

We have designated photographers at camp. Before camp starts you will be asked for permission for photographs taken of camp activities which include your child to be used for publicity purposes (without names). If your child brings a camera to camp, we will keep it in a safe place and allow them to use it during free time. Mobile phones are not allowed at *JaM Camp*. At *Get Real!* campers may bring phones but they will be taken off them and kept safe each night, and returned again in the morning. Any photos taken by your child including other people should be kept for personal use and not shared on internet sites without their permission.

Data protection

The data we hold on you and your child(ren) is legitimately used in order for camp to run safely and effectively. In order to inform you about future camps, we will continue to hold your contact details after camp finishes. Your child's medical information helps us to ensure that they are properly looked after while in our care, and it in no way jeopardises his or her place at camp. Medical forms will be seen by the camp co-ordinator, camp nurse and only shared with leaders who are directly responsible for your child's care. If it is necessary for your child to see a medical professional whilst at camp, the information you have provided will be shown to them in order for your child to receive the most effective care. You may ask us to delete your information at any time but please be aware that if you do so before or during camp, your child(ren) will be unable to continue to attend as the information is necessary for the safe and practical running of camp. If your child is involved in a safeguarding incident or a major medical situation it is a legal requirement for us to keep their information and we will be unable to delete it, even if you ask us to.
