## Explaining the gospel

Someone has said that explaining the gospel is a translation issue. Children can understand the gospel and respond to it if it is explained to them in a way they can understand.



## Practical Tip

Use the following idea to explain "Jesus died for me." Make a large cross from thick card. Stick a small mirror in the center of the cross bar. Attach another piece of card (the same colour as the cross), making a flap which covers the mirror. Stick a picture of Jesus or write the name 'Jesus' on this card. As you talk about him dying in our place, let the children take turns holding the cross and ask them who Jesus died for as they lift up the flap and look in the mirror. This is a powerful visual way to help the children understand that Jesus died for them.
